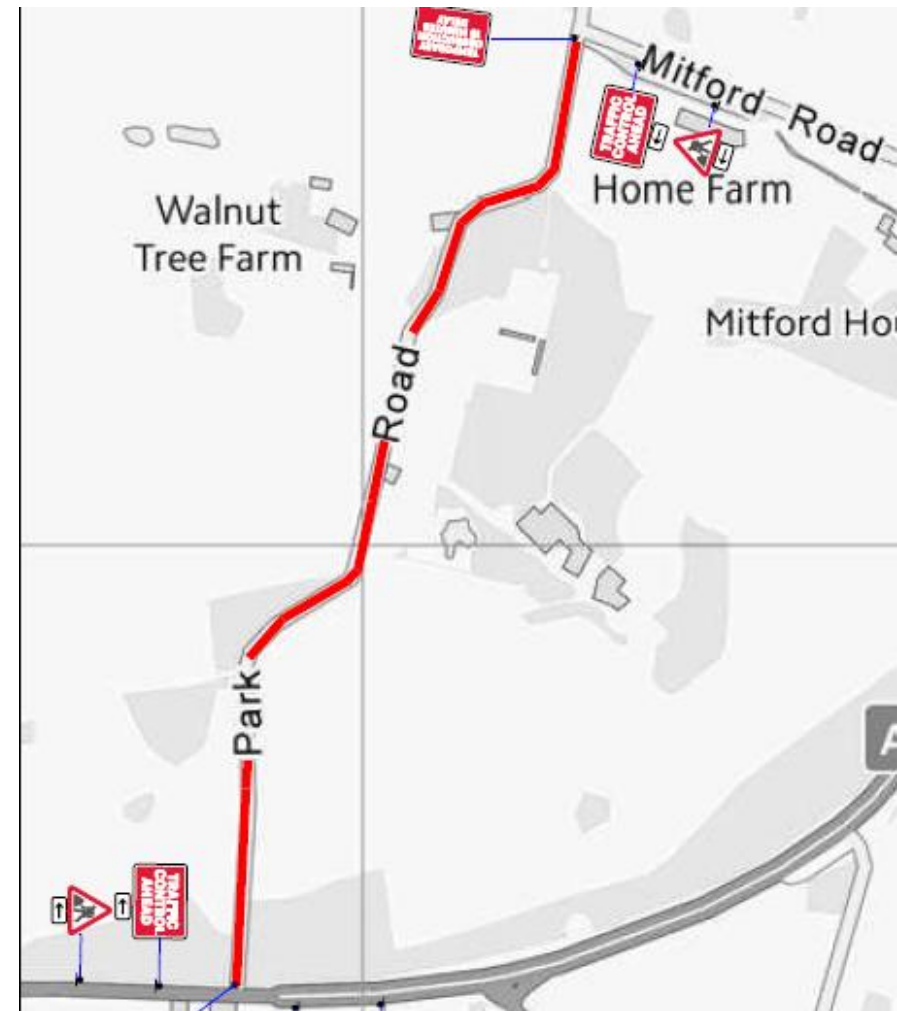

Two Village Bypass – Q2 2026

- **Archaeology:** 9 areas completed, the last remaining area is underway at TVB Central.
- **Utility diversion works:** 4 no. diversions complete. 3 no. diversions remaining.
- **Haul road:** route from east to west nearing completion, Bailey bridge being installed at the River Alde to complete haul road connectivity (see next slide).
- **Compound:** The main site compound access and cabins at Tinker Brook are complete (see next slide)
- **Main Works:** Piling platforms at the River Alde have commenced, with the west platform complete and east platform underway, earthworks activities have commenced across the site.
- **Friday St:** See previous slides.



Two Village Bypass - Site Images



A temporary Bailey Bridge has been installed at the River Alde by Galliford Try. The bridge creates a vital link to support construction traffic, enabling works to progress on the construction of the permanent highway bridge.



The main site compound at Tinker Brook is commissioned and open for use by site staff.

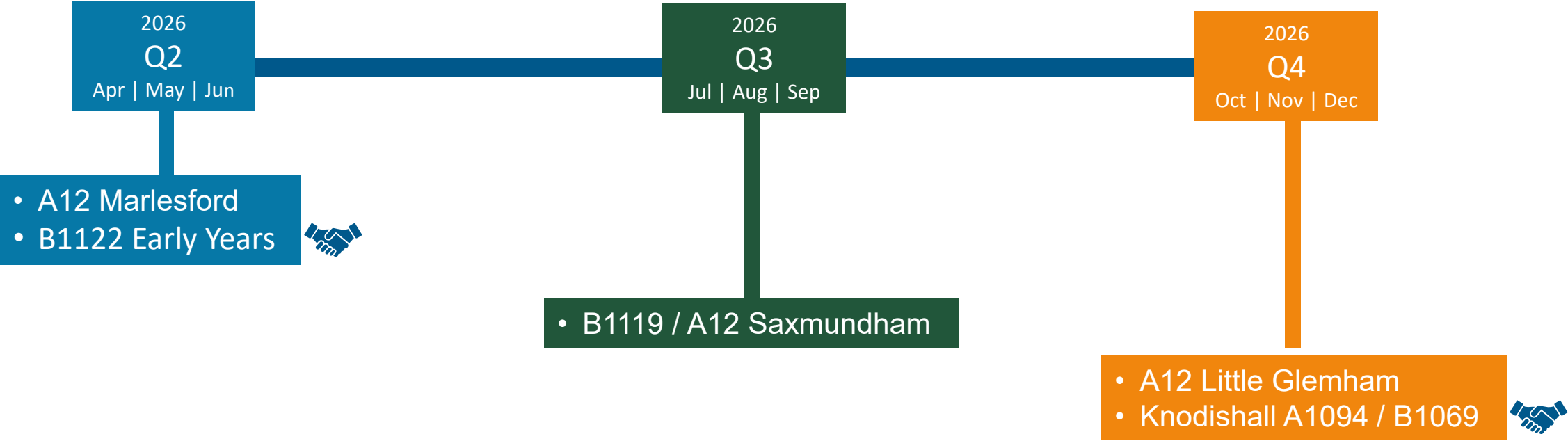


The River Alde piling platforms have commenced, with the west platform complete and east platform underway, the piling platforms will be used to install circa 3000 ground improvement piles either side of the new highway bridge.

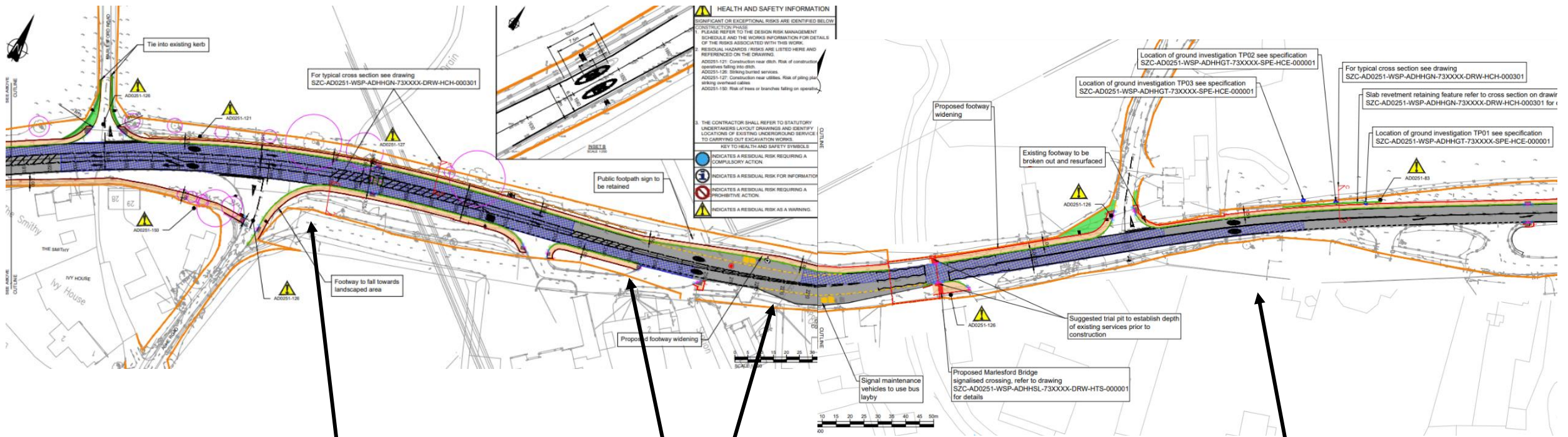

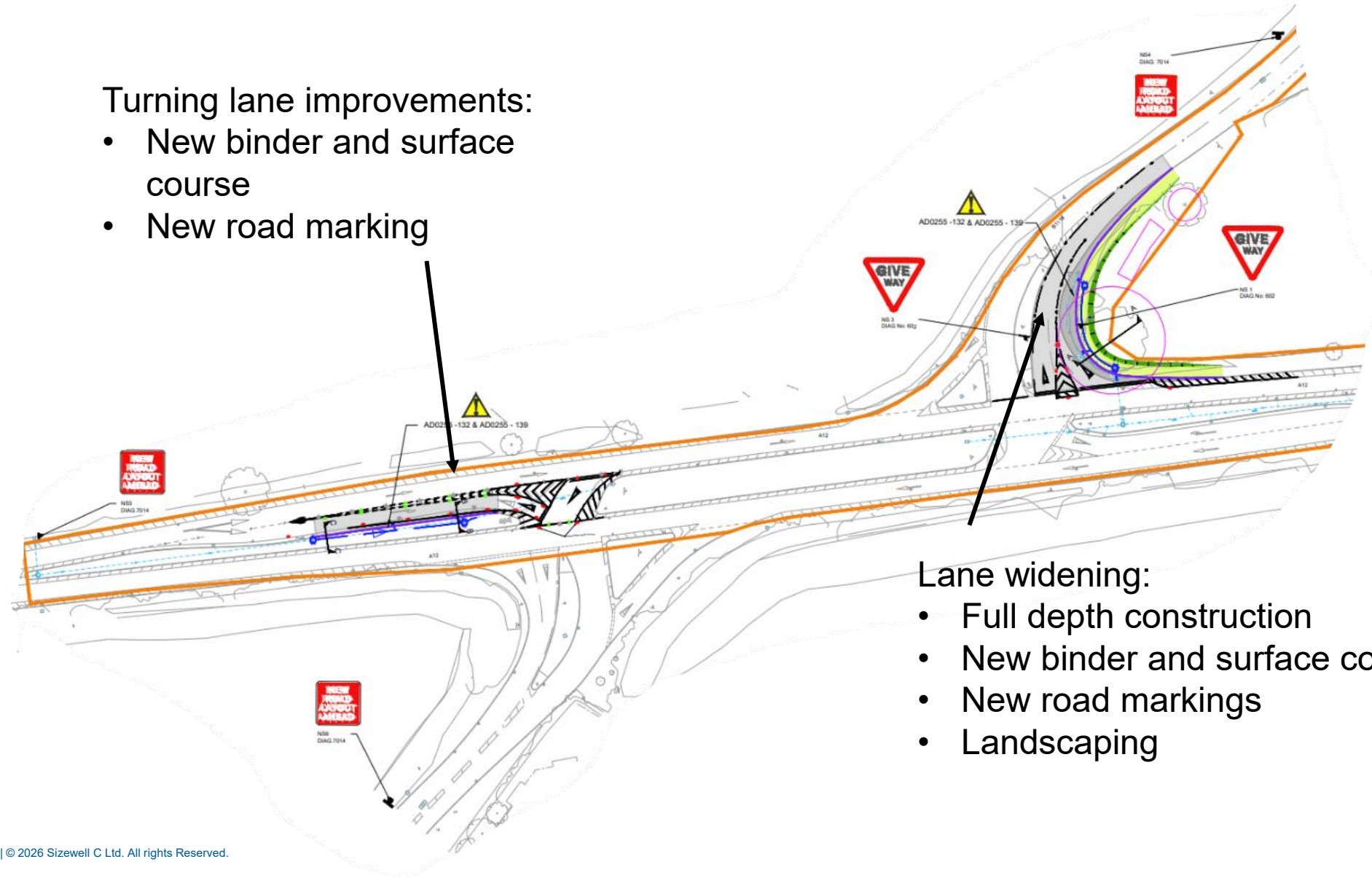

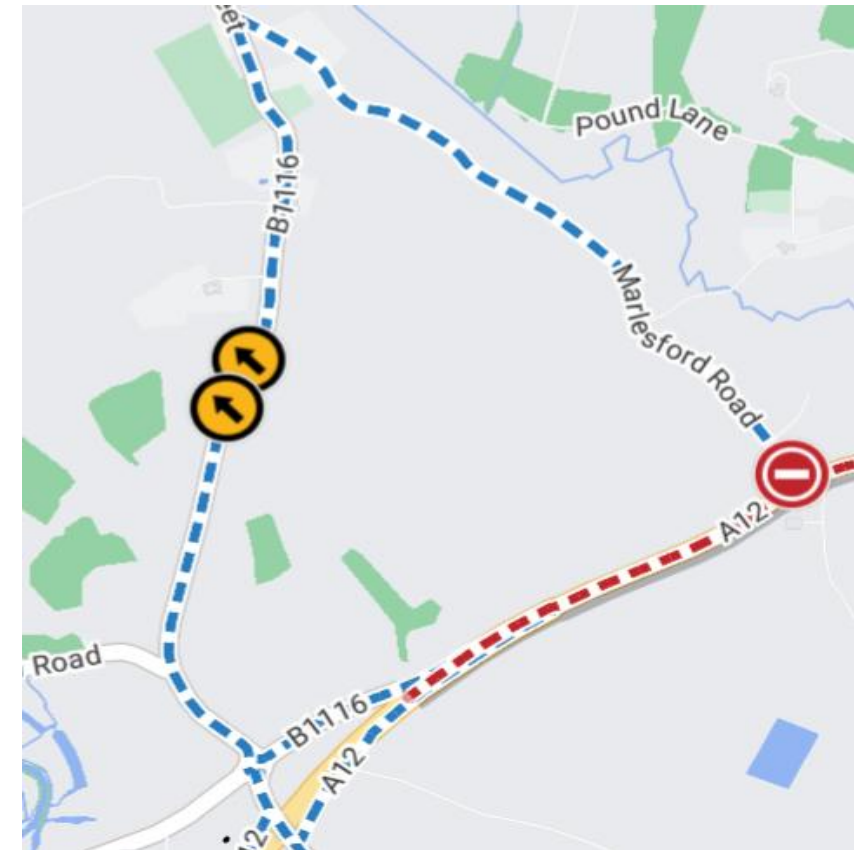

Summary of A12 Diversion – Nighttime south of B1122

All diversions are agreed with Suffolk County Council. The general principle is that the diversion route should be the same category of road as the road being closed, however, this is not always possible, and the character of the roads may not be identical.

When closing the A12 south of B1122 at nighttime, we can use the A1152, B1069 and B1122, unless otherwise agreed with SCC.

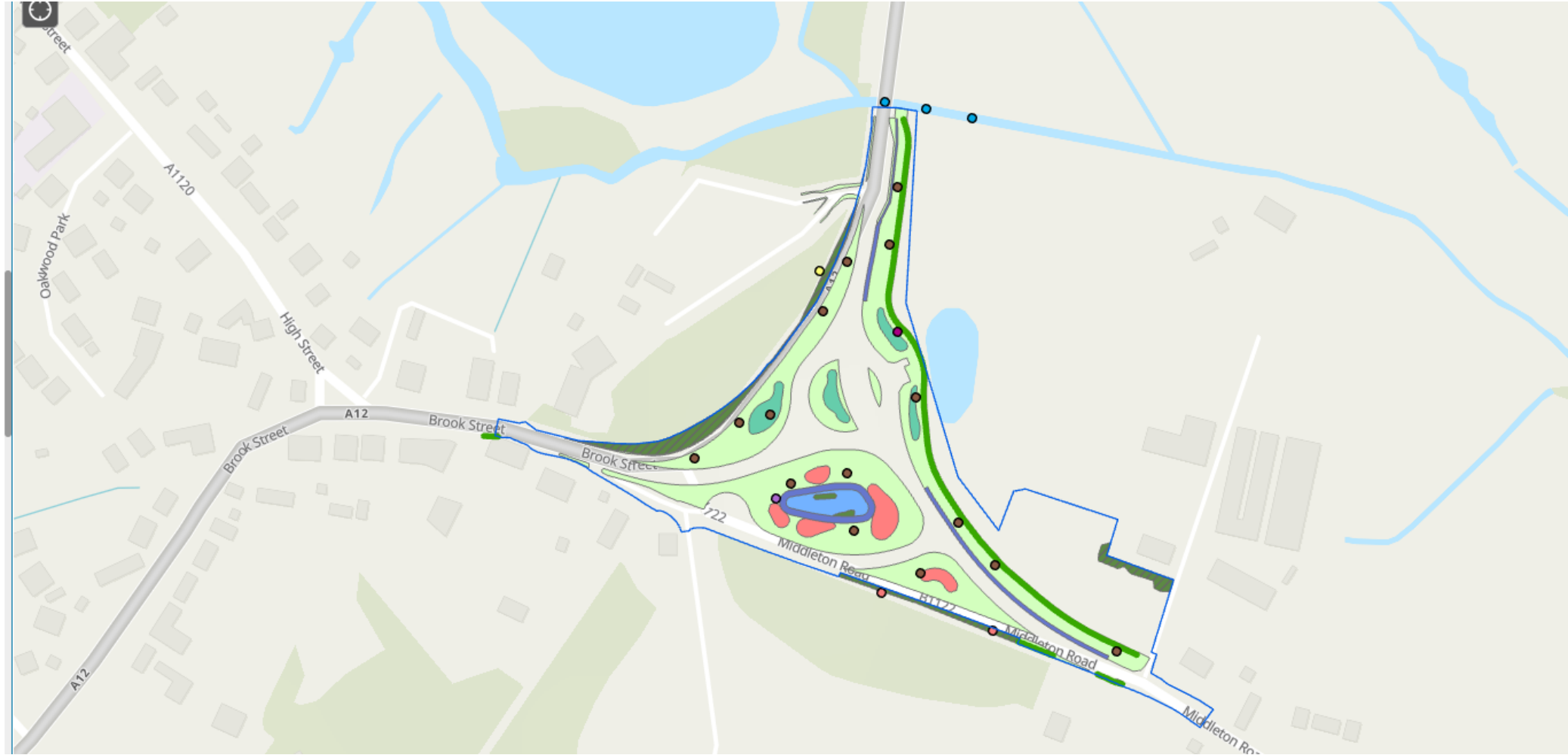
When closing the A12 north of B1122 or closing it during the day, the general requirement is to use the A14, A140, A143, A146, unless otherwise agreed with SCC.

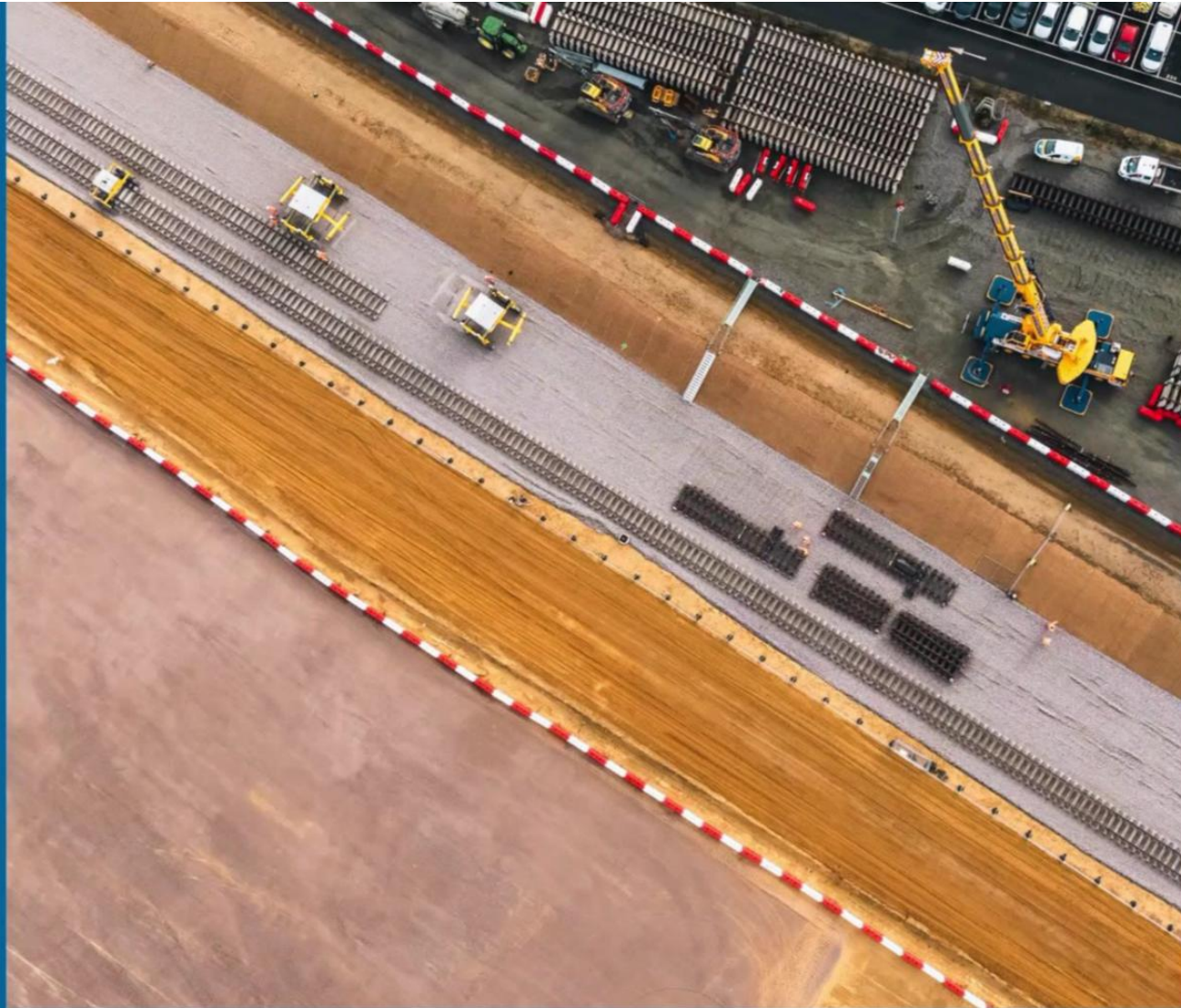

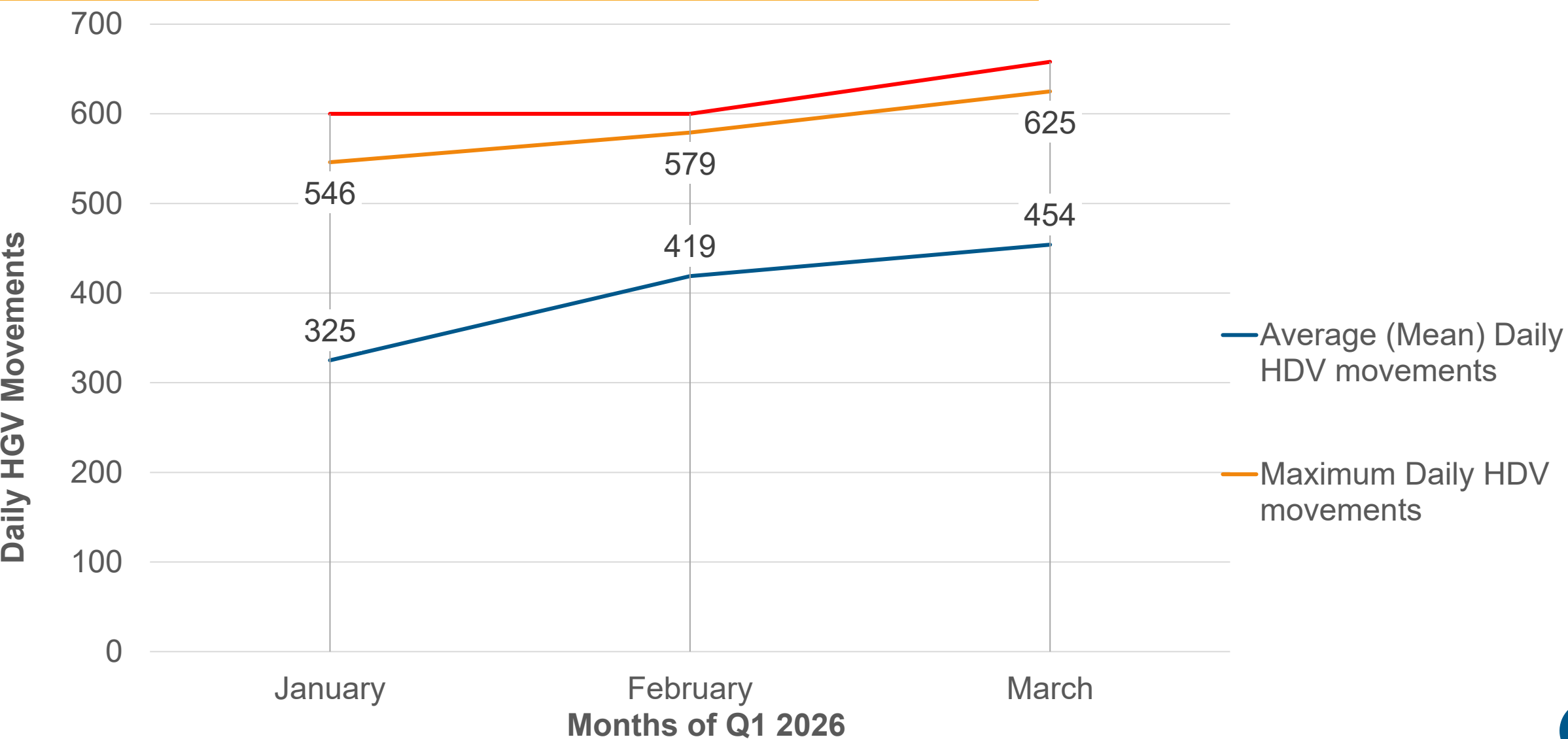

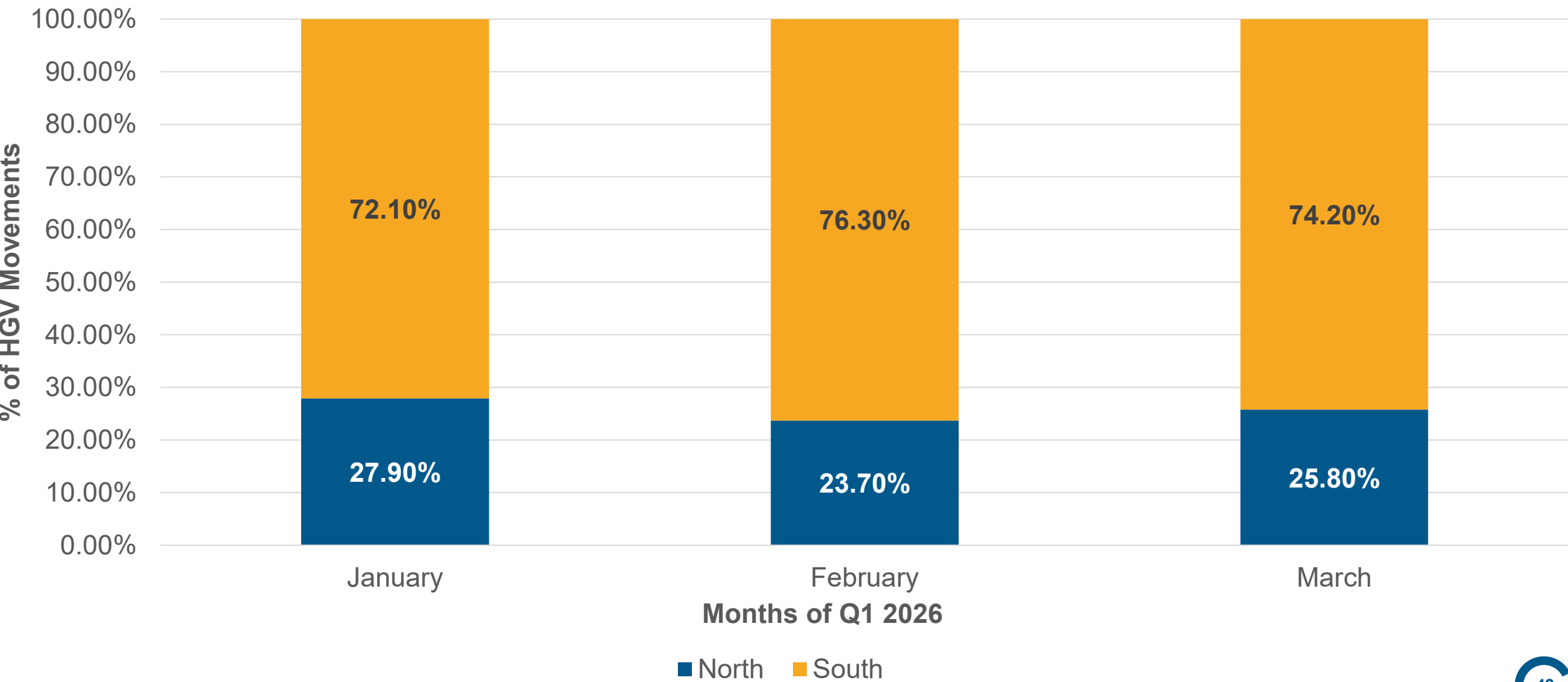

Average (mean) and Maximum Daily HGV Movements

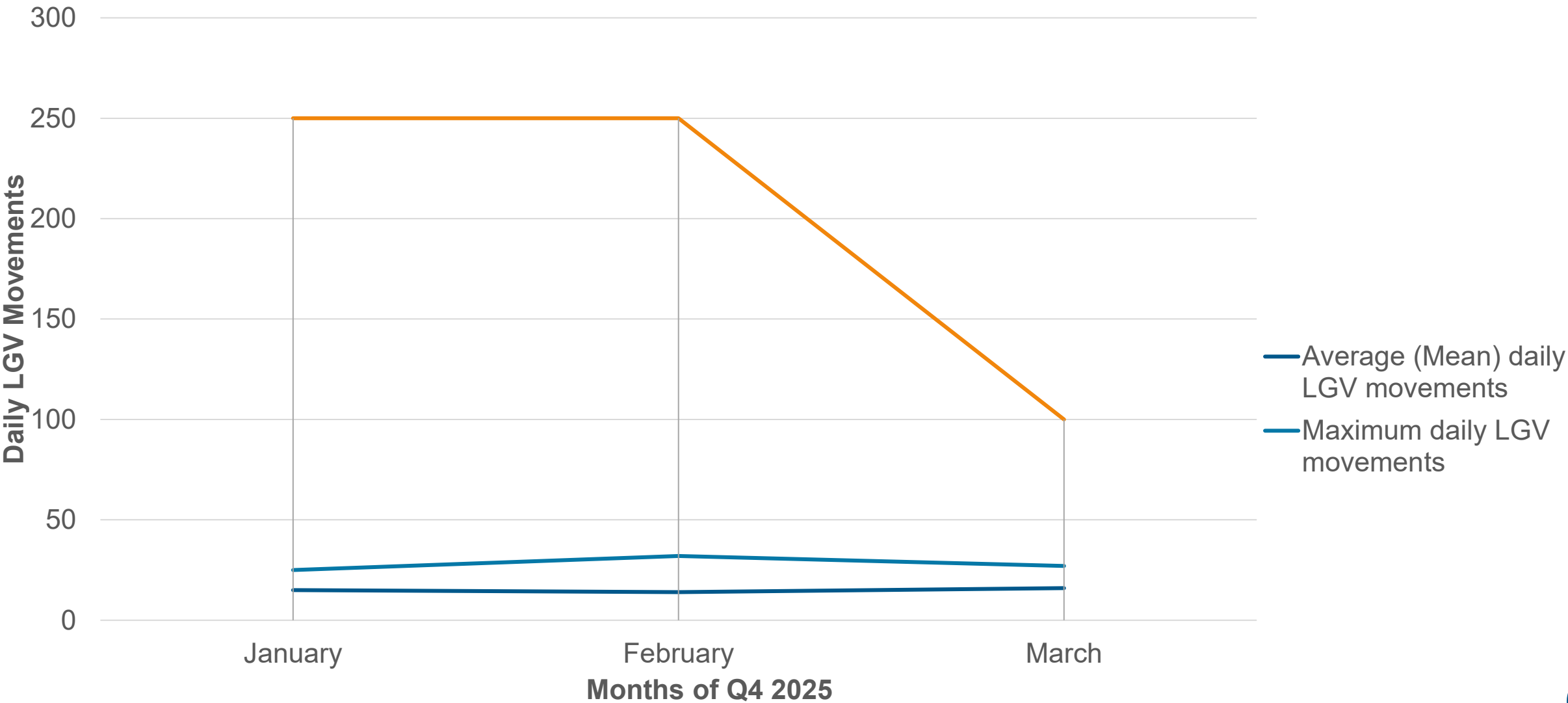


Directional Split of HGV Movements

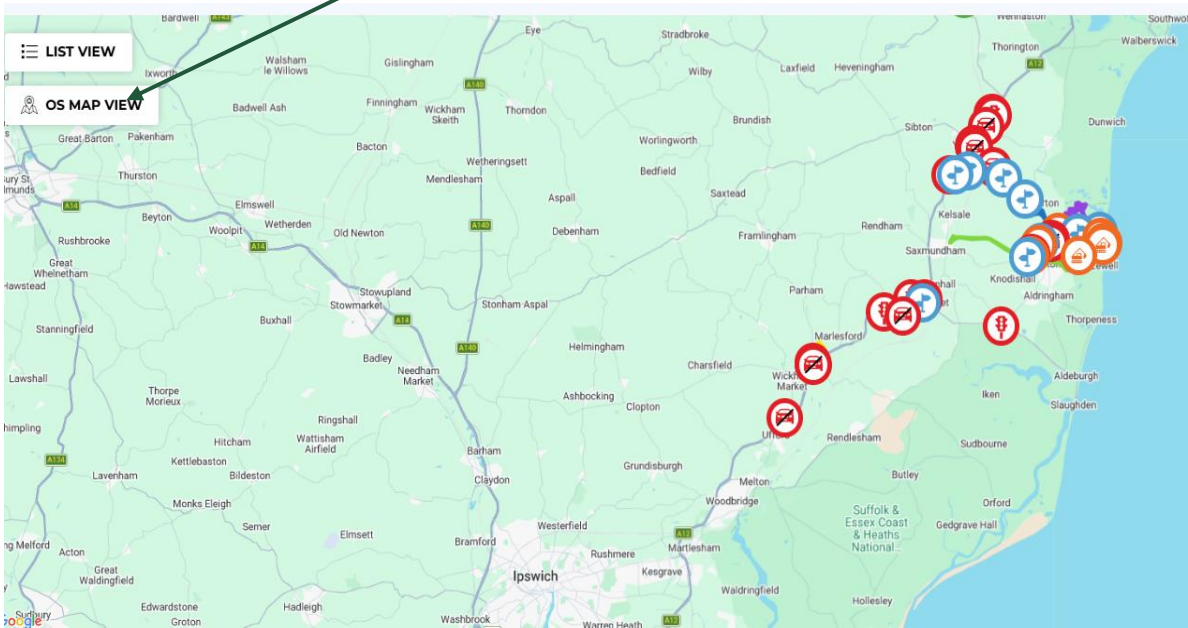

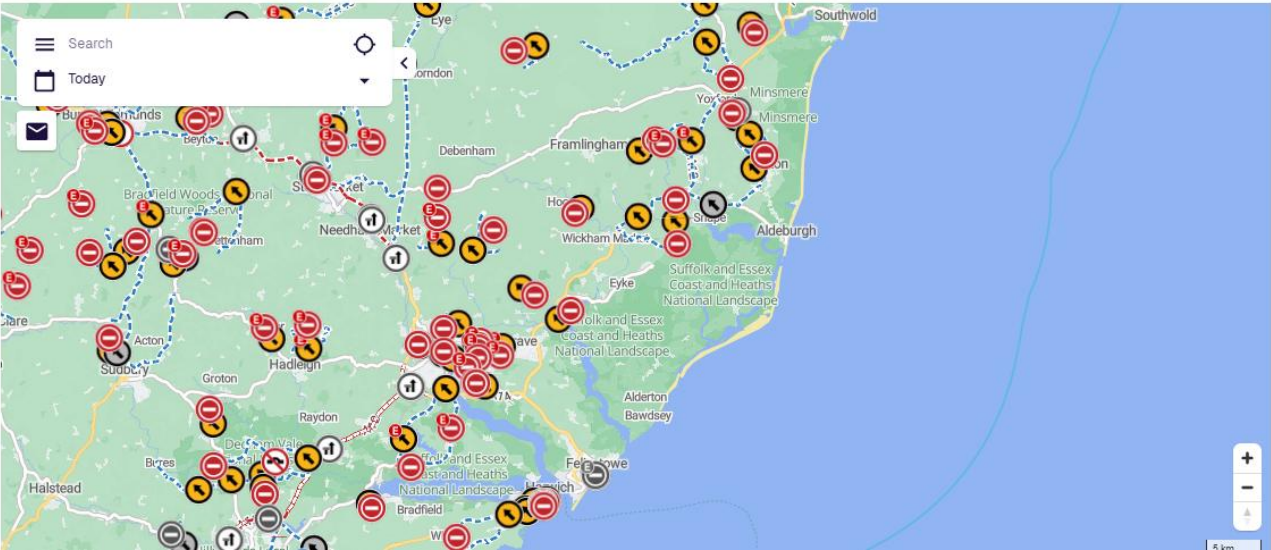

Item 5: Q&A

Via Town and Parish Council Representatives

Chair

Marlesford Parish Council

The Parish Working Group on traffic monitoring last met on 21 November 2025. In the Draft Notes of the March STF, it was recorded at para 4.03 that *“The TRG had reviewed the last round of traffic monitoring trends. A workshop would take place in March, while Rebecca Quigg would undertake one-to-one visits with parish councils”*. Marlesford therefore has two questions:

Q1. The last round of data referred to must mean October/November 2025 – where are the results? Unless we have missed it, we don’t believe a workshop was held in March.

Q2. Whilst we have had one to one meetings with Dr Quigg, these have not specifically been in relation to traffic monitoring.

Can SZC clarify the position on traffic monitoring reporting and explain whether the proposed quarterly reporting of data from permanent monitoring sites is going ahead?”

Melton Parish Council

Q1. On May 15th overnight road closures on the A12 at Marlesford for highway works arising from the Sizewell C scheme were announced by letter to locally affected residents as commencing on 1st June and also for as yet unspecified dates in July, August and September. While supporting the elements of the scheme proceeding in consultation with Marlesford Parish Council, it is noted that the diversion route includes the A1152 through Melton where local community sensitivity is heightened as this route is heavily used and includes the Melton level crossing. Melton Parish Council were not advised or consulted by the SZC Community Relations team or SCC Highways. Why?

Q2. SZC and a group of parishes last met to consider traffic monitoring over six months ago. More recently at the March STF meeting it was noted that the TRG had reviewed the last round of traffic monitoring data and a workshop would take place with key parishes but Melton PC is not aware that any such meeting took place.

It would, therefore, be helpful if SZC could clarify the arrangements (we thought previously agreed) whereby traffic monitoring reports would be discussed with those parishes most affected via a Teams meeting and with greater regularity than once or twice a year given that we had been advised that there would be quarterly reporting of data from permanent monitoring sites presumably as requested by the TRG.

Campsea Ashe Parish Council

Q1. During recent closures of the line between Woodbridge and Lowestoft, the bus replacement service has been using several minor and for large vehicles unsuitable lanes in Campsea Ashe. Ivy Lodge Road is a weight restricted road has also been regularly used. The reason for the TO there is that it is in parts very narrow and hence dangerous to navigate not only for larger vehicles. If proof is needed, yet another frontal collision between cars happened again there recently. Can NR ensure that Bus Replacement Services in future will use appropriate routes?

Q2. Residents have complained about the noise & visual impacts of the SR&P. Whilst SzC decided not to plant on the bund, we would like to query whether SzC will re-appraise that decision, should repeated complaints about impacts continue?

Q1. At the 4th March meeting, a question was raised about the SZC stance regarding solar panels on warehouses, buildings and its transport infrastructure, given the commitment to electric buses and other transport initiatives. The response - unfortunately not minuted - was that SZC were committed to installing solar panels and other green energy initiatives where viable.

Q2. Given climate change and other developments, why have SZC not installed solar carports at the two Park and Ride facilities? This is common practice in many European countries both to shield vehicles from direct sunlight and heavy rain but also to generate green energy and water recycling. A good example is in almost all motorway service areas across the road network in both France and Italy. This practice is being adopted as part of UK Government energy and transport policy advice.

Woodbridge Town Council

Q1. Woodbridge Town Council has noted, alongside Melton Parish Council, a significant increase in traffic using the B1438 through Woodbridge and along Melton Hill/Road to join the A1152 at Melton Crossroads as an increasing number of drivers become aware of roadworks/closures on the A12. The B1438 through this area has areas of high pedestrian use and unsignalised pedestrian crossing to and from many substandard width pavements. It would be appreciated if SZC/SCC would consider signing before the A12/B1438 junction AVOID USING B1438/B1069 TO ACCESS THE A1152 and at Melton Crossroads AVOID USING B1438 TO ACCESS A12 SOUTHBOUND.

Q2. Woodbridge Town Council has noted Network Rail (NR) Deadline 7 submission during the Examination of National Grid Electricity Transmission's Sealink project where it expresses severe concerns that NGET seeks to remove from NR various rights to control the operational use of the railway within the Sealink DCO and allow unfettered use/control of the land by NGET. This could have severe consequences on the overall transport strategy for Sizewell C and impact on road traffic. What action, if any, is being taken to curb NGET ambitions to be able to close the line at will.
